Guidelines

- 1) This a mandatory event for all students participating in (SC)².
- 2) This is a non-scored, non-medaled event.
- 3) Maximum 5 minute interview conducted with judge(s) as interviewer. There will be one student being interviewed by the judge(s).
- 4) Student must select to be interviewed for an entry-level position in any chosen career field in Colorado.
 - a) Selection of position must be made prior to interview and student will inform judge/interviewer at start of interview.
 - b) Students will be asked several questions, some common to interview situations, with the number of questions dependent on the length of answers given.
 - c) Student is required to have a resume.

Evaluation

- Students will be given feedback on their performance using the rubric on the following page. Please review rubric for specific criteria.
- In every event, students are expected to present themselves in a professional manner.

Scoring

- o Judges will provide a brief feedback rubric for each student.
- o Feedback rubrics will be returned to teachers in their envelopes at the end of the competition.
