Course Description	As developmentally appropriate, this course is meant to serve as a support class to ACE CTE students who are co-enrolled in a specific CTE cluster sequence. Ideally, this support would allow the student to complete a specific CTE cluster pathway. The ACE Teacher does not supply the technical skill content. Students will demonstrate levels of self-awareness, career exploration, academic planning based upon Postsecondary aspirations and realistic options as well as employability skills.  *This course is NOT to be delivered as a credit recovery, study hall or access/study skills course. This course MUST be linked directly to a CTE program.
